## Color Chart

When using stops on my program the colors that appear on your machine will be different (more along dst format colors) from the pictures entirely and may tell you to change colors at a stop. Do not change colors till the instructions tell you on this sheet as it's not necessary. Please use colors on this sheet or the ones you choose to replace the ones used and follow the color change instructions below to get the proper results.

<b>2</b>	<b>1893</b>	<b>Aqua</b>
<p>1. When machine stops remove hoop. At this point cut two pieces of matching fabric at least ¼ inch (I prefer to cut mine ½ inch bigger all around so I can get a nice grip on the fabric without stretching or pulling the fabric too much) all around larger than the outline for the sleeves of the kimono using your favorite method or you can use Embroidery Adhesive spray and spray the back of the two fabric pieces and center on the outlines at the bottom sides of the kimono and smooth flat. (I also us Steam a Seam 2 in a ½ inch roll. Wonderful stuff!)</p> <p>2. Replace hoop and sew the top outlines on top of fabric of sleeves and the machine will stop.</p> <p>3. Remove hoop and trim fabric around sleeves. Leave a tiny bit of fabric past the outline so fabric will not fray loose during finishing process(2-3mm). Cut out fabric for dress and following step 1 place over dress outline.</p> <p>4. Replace hoop and sew out next frame which will put the outline on top of the dress fabric.</p> <p>5. Remove hoop and trim fabric as close as possible to the outlines without cutting lines or pulling fabric loose. Leave a tiny bit of fabric past the outline so fabric will not fray loose during finishing process(2-3mm)</p> <p>Replace hoop and finish sewing out the remaining colors.</p>
